

## **THE DICKINSON CUP (WHS Index + to 20.4 playing off 95%)**

Clubs are invited to hold qualifying Medal rounds in the month of May of the current year

Weekend and weekday competitions must be held but, should a player enter both, only her first score counts

Members may only enter the qualifying competition at their Home Club

The qualifier shall be the player returning the Best Nett score in the handicap category stated above. If the qualifier is unable to enter the Handicap Championship her place may only be taken by the next best score

Ladies Competition Secretaries must notify the winners that they have qualified to compete for the Dickinson Cup at the Handicap Championship

They must also notify the name of the qualifier to the SLCGA Competition Secretary by **30th June 2021**

Should a Dickinson qualifier increase her handicap above 20.4 prior to the Handicap Championship she may still compete for the Dickinson Cup but must play off her original handicap

Her score will still count towards any other prizes on offer at the Championship

Play will be in 3's - Please enter with partners, or individually and partners will be allocated.

Start sheets will be published on the SLCGA website and sent the Club Delegates 14 days before the date of the Championship
