



GENERAL RULES GOVERNING ALL COUNTY COMPETITIONS

1. All entrants must be a member of an affiliated Somerset County Golf Club and hold a WHS Handicap Index on the day of the competition.
2. All competitions will be run in accordance with WHS conditions.
3. Entry to competitions will be via Intelligent Golf on the SGU website, or via the link on the SLCGA competition page. Where possible players will input scores via the Intelligent Golf app.
4. The correct entry fee must be forwarded to the Treasurer via BACS and clearly stating which competition the fee is for. If the entry fee is not received three weeks before the day of the competition, then the entry will be deleted.

5. Start sheets will be published 2 weeks before the competition date, after which replacements may be allowed in specific circumstances. Refunds/cancellations by BACS but there will be no refunds after the publication of the start sheet.
6. Full and Associate members (those who have paid a per capita fee) are the only players entitled to play in all County Competitions, with the exception of the County Championship where only full members may play. Full members are the only players eligible to play for the County in the England County Golf Championship.
7. The Home Club is the club that is responsible for maintaining the players Handicap Index
8. Ties on stroke play shall be decided on last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes. In the event of a tie still existing it will be decided on 2, 4 etc.
9. Late arrivals, Rules of golf rule 5.3a applies
10. Caddie - see definition - Rules of Golf
11. Distance measuring devices only are permitted in all County Competitions.
12. Buggies may be used for all County Competitions, see separate policy on use of.

13. Trophies are presented at the end of each competition. Additionally, the Rogers Cup, the Centenary Plate and the Grass Roots Trophy are represented to the winning club's Ladies Captain at the SLCGA AGM. All winners of trophies MUST arrange engraving of the trophy. The County Hon. Treasurer will reimburse the cost of engraving on presentation of an invoice.

14. A player may win multiple cups but only one voucher. except for the Dickinson Cup and Barlow Cup winners, who may win two vouchers if they also win the Handicap Championship Medal or Stableford.

15. See individual competitions for specific governing guidelines.

16. Players MUST abide by the current Covid regulations and any additional measures requested by the host club.

17. The Executive Committee reserves the right to make alterations to meeting without warning and to refuse entry without stating a reason. Any disputes must be referred to the Executive
