Somerset Ladies County Golf Association (SLCGA) was formed in 1901 by representatives of Burnham & Berrow, Bath and Weston Super Mare golf clubs so that Somerset ladies could join the county Championship which the LGU had instituted in 1899. At the present time there are 32 Affiliated Clubs.

Function of the SLCGA

- To organise golf competitions and team events throughout the year for the enjoyment of players of all ages and abilities. These events are open to all SLCGA members
- To encourage the opportunity to play social, competitive golf at several different courses each year
- To communicate information to all affiliated clubs in the county
- To give up to date information and advice as necessary

Data gathered

- Names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, CDH numbers collected for competition entries
- Data is collected via email and competition entry forms

How that data is used

- May be sent to all lady secretaries or county delegates of all affiliated clubs
- No data is used for marketing or mailing lists
- No data used on SLCGA website
- Data is used to inform clubs and players of events

Why the data us needed

- For communication and function of the Association
- To ensure compliance with SLCGA rules and regulations
- To enable matches and competitions to be arranged
- To inform clubs of events
