4. Chairman's Report. Sandra Ford. [Verbal Report]

Sandra gave a quick update concerning T&P. They have changed the 'Courtesy of course' privilege for Somerset Clubs, despite this year's County Captain being one of their club members. They are currently proposing to charge £360 for a match against another county. Discussions are on-going to improve this situation via the SGU.
