USGA Course Rating Team Leader

Person Specification

Member of an Affiliated Golf Club.

Interested and/or Experienced in Golf Course rating, SSS assessments.

Good knowledge of golf at all levels.

Preferably a lower handicapped golfer (15 or less, or has been a single figure handicap golfer).

Good communication skills.

Organised with good attention to detail.

Knowledge of/interest in the Rules of Golf.

Role Description

Recruit assistant course rating team members to make up your ratings team. (2 assistants per course rating Team Leader)

Train and mentor assistants.

Plan rating schedule to meet England Golf requirements.

Liaise with clubs to arrange rating. Provide details of what the clubs need to do prior to the rating teams visit.

Complete paperwork for each rating before sending to England Golf.

Liaise with clubs about changes to courses that might affect their rating.

Liaise with new clubs to assist in course setup as per CONGU/USGA regulations.

Complete expense forms and disburse monies when received to team members.

Availability May to October (the playing season to carry out course ratings).

Rating Teams will comprise of the following:

2 Course Rating Team Leaders

3/4 Assistant course rating team members (dependent on course/sets of tees to be rated).

All course rating team members will be expected to rate all set of tees and understand the differences that male and female golfers experience in line with the USGA rating variances.

The number of rating teams depends on the number of courses within each county; each team is expected to rate 10% of courses in their region per year, which will result in all courses in each county being rated within 10 years.
